



ACCESS FORM

Conditions of entry to Aorangi Awarua Trust lands are as follows :

1. Trees are not to be cut or disturbed.
2. Formed tracks are to be used where-ever possible, new tracks are not to be made.
3. Open fires are not to be lit.
4. **Firearms** are not to be taken into the block (Hunting Permits are available)
5. **No dogs or pets** are allowed to be taken onto the land.
6. **All rubbish** is to be removed and taken out with you.
7. Waahi tapu and historic sites are not to be disturbed.
8. The Aorangi Awarua Trust SHALL NOT accept liability for individual/s, or groups who have permission of the Trust to enter Trust managed lands for the purposes of cultural (hikoi), educational, recreation.
9. A fee is applicable please refer policy at end of form.
10. **Health & Safety** – all members accessing the land must complete AAT Health and Safety Induction process, sign attached form and return with this form.
11. The Trust accepts the organizer(s) have read, completed and signed this declaration before entering onto the block and a copy of this declaration is returned to the Trust Administrator PO Box 5 Ratana 4548 or email sorayapm@xtra.co.nz.

	<p>Individual activities are not encouraged by the Trust as this is a high risk.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Individuals must provide the Trust with an activity plan stating your entry and exit plan including your contact people and their details 	
	<p>Hunting:</p> <p>Where my activity involves hunting I hold a current firearms licence. Remain within the area you have been designated to. There may be hunters in other areas.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Follow the firearms code Positively identify target before shooting Wear Hi-Viz Clothing at all times Night time hunting is not permitted <p>If you come across or sight anyone in your designated area report back to the Aorangi Awarua 1DB2 Land Trust.</p>

	<p>Conservation (Protection of Endangered Species):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Protected Native Species such as Kiwi, Whiowhio (Blue Duck) are not to be disturbed in any way No damage is permitted to Native Flora/Fauna/Trees/Wildlife that impacts upon Conservation Use existing tracks. Creating new tracks is not permitted 	
	<p>Poison Bait Traps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Keep away from all Rodent Bait Traps on the property. 	
	<p>Weather: Weather and Temperatures can change very quickly. Ensure you come prepared for the elements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Appropriate Warm Clothing Weather Proof Jackets and Trousers Sturdy Footwear or Boots 	
	<p>Steep Terrain/Land Subsidence/Tomo– from time to time land subsidence or tomo (holes) may appear in the ground resulting from heavy rain/weather conditions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Extreme care must be taken on steep terrain. 	
	<p>Crossing Rivers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take care when crossing rivers and streams as they can rise very quickly. 	
	<p>First Aid Kits: When coming onto Lands administered by the Aorangi Awarua 1DB2 Land Trust you are required to bring your own First Aid Kit.</p>	
	<p>Quad Bikes and Farm Vehicles: Extreme care must be taken when using quad bikes and farm vehicles. Wear helmets at all times when operating Quad Bikes.</p>	
	<p>Dog Access: No dogs permitted unless authorised by the Trust.</p>	
	<p>Horse Access: No horses permitted.</p>	
	<p>Prevent Wildfires: Light no fires. Call 111 to report any out of control fires.</p>	
	<p>There are Native Bees, Bee Hives and Wasps on the property.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure you have medication in case of allergies 	
	<p>Native Stinging Nettle/Toxic Plants: Native Stinging Nettle or Ongaonga are a particularly toxic weed if it comes into contact with the skin especially with children. Seek first aid treatment straight away.</p>

	<p>“Leave all gates as you find them”. If you open a gate then close it again. That way any stock on the property and yourself stay safe.</p>	
	<p>Keep huts CLEAN and tidy: Keep the hut and toilets clean and tidy. When you leave close all doors and windows. Take care when using gas or fires in the huts. Take ALL rubbish with you when you leave Report to the Aorangi Awarua 1DB2 Land Trust:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any property damage and, • If the hut is left in an unclean state 	
	<p>Be careful where you access your drinking water sources. If in doubt boil or treat the water.</p>	
	<p>Reporting of Incidents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All Near Misses, Incidents, Accidents and Hazards are to be reported to the Trust immediately <p>Insurance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All contractors must have their own indemnity insurance.
